#### Appendix A: Explanation of Clinician Credentials

- **CADC:** Certified Alcohol and Other Drug Counselor: These individuals may or may not have a master's degree and/or license, but have extensive training in providing substance abuse treatment. CADC is a certification in provision of substance abuse services.
- LCSW: Licensed Clinical Social Worker: Clinicians who have the highest licensure level as a master's degree level social worker. LSW/MSW is the first tier social work license that is earned prior to the LCSW.
- LCPC: Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor: Clinicians who have the highest licensure level as a master's degree level counselor. LPC is the first tier counseling license that is earned prior to the LCPC.
- LMFT: Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist: Clinicians who have a master's degree and specialize in couples/family therapy. MFT is the first tier counseling license that is earned prior to the LMFT.
- **Psy.D:** Licensed Clinical Psychologists who have a doctorate degree in Psychology. They do not prescribe medications but do conduct psychological testing, fitness for duty evaluations, and provide a variety of therapy services

- **Ph.D:** Licensed Clinical Psychologists who have a doctorate degree in Psychology. They do not prescribe medications but do conduct psychological testing, fitness for duty evaluations, and provide a variety of therapy services
- Ed.D: Clinicians who have a doctorate degree in Mental Health Counseling and Higher Education. They often teach counseling at universities to master's and doctoral level counselors-in-training in addition to providing mental health services. They do not prescribe medications or conduct psychological testing, but do facilitate certain types of evaluations. These clinicians also provide a high variety of therapy services. These clinicians have the LCPC license because only psychologists have a license that specifically indicates a doctorate in psychology.
- **DSW:** Clinicians who have a doctorate degree in Social Work. They do not prescribe medications or conduct psychological testing, but do facilitate certain types of evaluations. These clinicians also provide a high variety of therapy services. These clinicians have the LCSW license because only psychologists have a license that specifically indicates a doctorate in psychology.
- **Psychiatrist**: A medical doctor that specializes in prescribing psychiatric medications. Psychiatrists rarely provide counseling services; they primarily prescribe medications.
- The above credentials reflect the slight variations between social workers, counselors, psychologists, and psychiatrists; all of whom provide a variety of mental health services.
